WE WELCOME YOU TODAY

We would like to remind our visitors of the following::

- All people are encouraged to participate in the sacred services of our Church. We hope that you will be able to worship as well as have fellowship with us. Should you wish any information about the Orthodox Faith or this parish in particular, please see the rector or any member of the church. We are able to place you on our mailing list.
- Only Orthodox Christians may receive the Eucharist (Holy Communion) in the Orthodox Church. In like manner, Orthodox Christians may not receive the sacraments in an non-Orthodox Church. While we hope that one day all Christians will find unity and be able to approach the chalice of our Lord together, we observe the teachings of the Church that the Eucharist is a gift of unity and not a means of unity.

We remind our faithful and visitors of the following guidelines concerning the Holy Sacraments in the Orthodox Church.

- Orthodox Christians are urged to receive Holy Communion frequently.
- Communicants should be at peace with others before approaching the chalice(Mt 5:23-24)
- Realize the importance of making a thorough examination of sins and transgressions against God, ourselves and others and having prayed for forgiveness before coming to Holy Communion.
- Frequent communicants should come to Holy Confession at least four times a year (during the four fasting periods of the year). and additionally when an examination of conscience reveals the necessity to do so in order to heal any sinful behavior.
- Communicants should fast from all foods and liquids from the evening before receiving Holy Communion.
- Communicants should read prayers in preparation for receiving Holy Communion.
- All Orthodox Christians must receive the sacraments at least once a year.
- Those who are late for Divine Liturgy (after the reading of the Epistle and Gospel) should not approach the chalice.
- Those who are ill or who have special physical needs are exempt from the above guidelines.
- Infants and children (up to the age of seven) who are Orthodox Christians may receive Holy Communion and are exempt from the above guidelines.

Thank you for gathering to worship with us today. Together we have glorified the One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. May we be brought closer to one another and closer to God by following the eternal teachings of our Lord.



TROPARION TO THE RESURRECTION – TONE 4

When the women disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the joyous message of Thy Resurrection; they cast away the ancestral curse and elatedly told the apostles: Death is overthrown! Christ God is risen, granting the world great mercy.

TROPARION TO THE FOREFATHERS— TONE 2

By faith You justified the Forefathers, when through them You betrothed Yourself beforehand to the Church of the Gentiles. The saints boast in glory, that from their seed there is a glorious fruit: she who bore You without seed. By their prayers, O Christ God, save our souls.

KONTAKION TO THE FOREFATHERS — TONE 6

You did not worship the graven image, O thriceblessed youths, but shielded by the ineffable Essence, you were glorified in your trial by fire. In the midst of the unbearable fire you called upon God, crying: "Hasten, O compassionate One. and

LESSON FROM THE EPISTLE OF ST. PAUL TO THE GOLOSSIANS

(c. 3, v. 4-11)

Brethren, when Christ appears from heaven, you also will appear in glory with him. Therefore, turn away from all the earthly cravings of your flesh, namely fornication, impurity, passion, evil desire, and avarice, which are as wicked as idolatry. Men, practicing these vices, arouse the wrath of God, because they disobey him.

Remember that you were guilty of these sins in the past. But now you must cast them all away, including anger, rage, malice, blasphemy, and obscenity. Do not lie to one another. For you are through with the old self and his practices. Now you have begun life as a new man, recreated in wisdom after the image of the creator. In this respect

there is no difference between Gentile and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian and Scythian, slave and freeman. For Christ is everything, and he lives in every one of you.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS: At the annual parish meeting held on Sunday, October 29, 2023, the parish voted to increase the base annual member obligation from \$600 to \$725 per member, effective beginning with the 2024 calendar year. The parish also voted to increase the cemetery plot fee from \$100 to \$200 per plot (vault right, not real estate title) effective in 2024, and the perpetual care fee paid at time of burial from \$400 to \$500 for members and from \$2,000 to \$2,200 for non-members. Any member who is unable to meet the financial obligations may request a hardship exemption. Exemption requests should be made in writing to the Parish Council.

<u>BASKET COLLECTION EXPLANATION</u>: The initial basket collection is generally for member obligations. Member obligations go toward the "General Fund" which pays the operating expenses of the church and church properties. <u>CORRECTION</u>: Any loose donations in the first collection go toward the Stewardship Fund. The <u>Stewardship Fund</u> is used to support charitable donations that the parish makes to other organizations. The second collection each Sunday goes toward Sunday School expenses. The third collection at the end of Liturgy at the dismissal is your gift to the Priest.

SCRIPTURE STUDY-The Monday evening class will be taking a brief hiatus over the Holiday's. Our next meeting will be on Monday the 8th of January when we will be discussing Chapter 23-34 of Deuteronomy. The Thursday morning class will meet next on Thursday the 28th of January when we will be discussing chapters 3-10 of 1st Kingdoms.

SVIATE VECHIR-This year's Holy Supper will be held on Saturday the 6th of January at 5:30 PM followed by the Nativity Compline at 7. If you are planning on attending, please let Pani Matka Alice know. The meal is meatless and if you are bringing a covered dish (We'll need a few deserts!) please let Pani Matka Alice know what you plan to bring.

<u>COUNCIL MEETING</u>: The December Parish Council meeting has been rescheduled for Wednesday, December 27, 2023, in the church hall, immediately following the 6:00PM Akathist service. All parishioners are welcome!

Stewardship THANK YOU FOR THESE RECENT DONATIONS:

Sponsor-A-Day Program: At the annual parish meeting held in October 2023 the parish voted to approve the Finance Committee's recommendation to implement a Sponsorship program to raise money for the church's General Fund. The General Fund is used to pay the day-to-day operating expenses of the church and church properties (Ex: utilities, insurance, salaries, etc.).


Our 10/2022-9/2023 General Fund expenses were approximately \$150,000 (10/21-9/22 was more, at approximately \$162,500) and our 2024 member obligations are \$725 per member. With about 100 members (our current membership), member obligations will cover about \$72,500 of expenses (less than half of our expected annual expenses). Historically, the gap between member obligations and expenses has been covered largely by the generous donations of our church organizations, parishioners, and friends. But, with so many (38) of our members passing away over the last 5 years, the gap is greater than ever.

The Sponsor-A-Day program is a way to contribute to the church's financial well-being beyond obligations. It costs approximately \$450 per day to operate the church, hall, and rectory. If you are able and interested in sponsoring a day of operating expenses (or a half day or any portion of a day), please include your sponsorship donation in your obligation envelopes (or any regular envelope), and specifically indicate that the donation is for the Sponsor-A-Day program (note it on your check/pmt).

Please note that this program is intended to be a <u>supplement</u> to member obligations. So, we only encourage participation if you are able to donate beyond your 2024 member obligations.

Follow-Up from IOCC Ukrainian Relief Dinner and Prayer Service

Held at

St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Cathedral, Pittsburgh, PA Sunday, September 24, 2023

Dear Friends of IOCC,

Thank you for your tremendous support of the Ukrainian Relief Dinner and Prayer Service that was held on September 24 at St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Pittsburgh. It is truly a blessing to be able to gather as an Orthodox community and accomplish such meaningful acts of mercy¹. As in the past, our Pittsburgh Committee is pleased to report the financial results of this event to the community. The following is a summary of our financial results:

Estimated Attendees: 375 People (Including approximately 75 volunteers)

• Gross Revenues: \$40,604

Expenses: \$5,165

Net Money Sent to IOCC for Ukrainian Relief: \$35,439

(Note: Our expenses were very low because many people and organizations donated their time, facilities, and resources (many people helped to make food, and purchase supplies). This allowed us to send the maximum amount of funds through to IOCC. These numbers only include reimbursed expenses.)

It is also important to remember that IOCC has been able to historically leverage each dollar that we raise as a community into seven dollars of aid that reaches beneficiaries (by qualifying for government and private grants). When we do the math, it means that this small gathering of Orthodox Christians in Pittsburgh will have enabled IOCC to deliver approximately \$348,000 worth of aid to Ukraine!! Glory to God!!

We thank God for a loving community, and for your generosity in helping our Ukrainian Brothers and Sisters in Christ.
