#### **WE WELCOME YOU TODAY**

#### We would like to remind our visitors of the following::

- All people are encouraged to participate in the sacred services of our Church. We hope that you will be able to worship as well as have fellowship with us. Should you wish any information about the Orthodox Faith or this parish in particular, please see the rector or any member of the church. We are able to place you on our mailing list.
- Only Orthodox Christians may receive the Eucharist (Holy Communion) in the Orthodox Church. In like manner, Orthodox Christians may not receive the sacraments in an non-Orthodox Church. While we hope that one day all Christians will find unity and be able to approach the chalice of our Lord together, we observe the teachings of the Church that the Eucharist is a gift of unity and not a means of unity.

#### We remind our faithful and visitors of the following guidelines concerning the Holy Sacraments in the Orthodox Church.

- Orthodox Christians are urged to receive Holy Communion frequently.
- Communicants should be at peace with others before approaching the chalice(Mt 5:23-24)
- Realize the importance of making a thorough examination of sins and transgressions against God, ourselves and others and having prayed for forgiveness before coming to Holy Communion.
- Frequent communicants should come to Holy Confession at least four times a year (during the four fasting periods of the year). and additionally when an examination of conscience reveals the necessity to do so in order to heal any sinful behavior.
- Communicants should fast from all foods and liquids from the evening before receiving Holy Communion.
- Communicants should read prayers in preparation for receiving Holy Communion.
- All Orthodox Christians must receive the sacraments at least once a year.
- Those who are late for Divine Liturgy ( after the reading of the Epistle and Gospel) should not approach the chalice.
- Those who are ill or who have special physical needs are exempt from the above guidelines.
- Infants and children (up to the age of seven) who are Orthodox Christians may receive Holy Communion and are exempt from the above guidelines.

Thank you for gathering to worship with us today. Together we have glorified the One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. May we be brought closer to one another and closer to God by following the eternal teachings of our Lord.

**тим**, хто часто причащається, слід приходити на святу сповідь принаймні чотири рази на рік (під час кожного із чотирьох щорічних постів);



By Thy Cross, Thou didst destroy death!
To the thief, Thou didst open Paradise! For the myrrh-bearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy! And Thou didst command Thy disciples, O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

#### Troparion to St. Gregory — Tone 4

By sharing in the ways of the Apostles, you became a successor to their throne. Through the practice of virtue, you found the way to divine contemplation, O inspired one of God; by teaching the word of truth without error, you defended the Faith, even to the shedding of your blood. Hieromartyr Gregory entreat Christ God to save our souls.

## Lesson from the Second Epistle of Saint Paul to the Corinthians (c. 6, v. 1-10)

Brethren, as a fellow worker of God, I entreat you not to receive the grace of God in vain. For he says in the Scripture: "I have listened to you at the proper time and helped you on the day of salvation." Behold, this is the proper time. Behold, this is the day of salvation.

I put no obstacle in anyone's path, so that my ministry may be blameless. I show myself as a minister of God in every respect; in great endurance; in afflictions; in disturbances; in distress; in stripes; in prisons; in riots; in labors; in vigils; in fastings; in charity; in knowledge; in long-suffering; in gentleness; in the Holy Spirit; in unfeigned love; in the preaching of the true doctrine; in the power of God; through the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left; through honor and disgrace; through defamation and glorification; as an impostor, though I tell the truth; as ignored, though I am well known; as dying, though I am alive; as tortured, though I am not yet killed; as sorrowful, though I am always rejoicing; as poor, though I am enriching many; as possessing nothing, though I possess everything.

### Sponsor-A-Day Program Update

At the annual parish meeting held in October 2023 the parish voted to approve the Finance Committee's recommendation to implement a Sponsorship program to raise money for the church's General Fund. The General Fund is used to pay the day-to-day operating expenses of the church and church properties (Ex: utilities, insurance, salaries, etc.).

Our 10/2022-9/2023 General Fund expenses were approximately \$150,000 (10/21-9/22 was more, at approximately \$162,500) and our 2024 member obligations are \$725 per member. With about 100 members (our current membership), member obligations will cover about \$72,500 of expenses (less than half of our expected annual expenses). Historically, the gap between member obligations and expenses has been covered largely by the generous donations of our church organizations, parishioners, and friends. But, with so many (38) of our members passing away over the last 5 years, the gap is greater than ever.

The Sponsor-A-Day program is a way to contribute to the church's financial well-being beyond obligations. It costs approximately \$450 per day to operate the church, hall, and rectory. If you are able and interested in sponsoring a day of operating expenses (or a half day or any portion of a day), please complete the form on the back of the bulletin and provide it, along with your donation, to Treasurer Brittany Brettell.

Please note that this program is intended to be a <u>supplement</u> to member obligations. So, we only encourage participation if you are able to donate beyond your 2024 member obligations. Thank you for your support! Parish Council


To be a member of parish council the candidate would have to have been a member of St. Peter and Paul parish for three years and be in good standing both spiritually and financially.

### Ukrainian heroine Tetiana Mialkovska to Visit the United States on Goodwill Tour

The Ukrainian Cultural and Humanitarian Institute (UCHI) will host renowned Ukrainian artist, art-therapist, humanitarian and nation rebuilder Tetiana Mialkovska October 2 - 30, 2024 for a four-week tour of presentations, demonstrations, and discussions of the great successes in early intervention trauma therapy that she has been applying in Ukraine to help orphaned and displaced children, widows, and soldiers whose lives have been torn apart by the war. Ukraine is in the forefront of the use of art therapy on a massive scale. The country has proven to be a crucible for resisting aggression when not amply supplied with sufficient capacity to defend itself with traditional military supplies. Ukraine has much to share with the US and the world with regard to the advances it has made.

Tetiana is the founder and director of the Ukrainian non-profit citizens' organization "Pyaternya," which runs the Warm Hands art therapy and skills development. The visit is funded by a private donor and not using funds donated to UCHI to help the children by the general public. It is a gesture of gratitude to the American people for the over \$250,000 in privately funded aid that UCHI has leveraged – every penny of which goes to assisting the children with full transparency showing gainful use of all funds provided.

Tetiana will explain how the war has affected the lives of orphans and other children displaced by the unprecedented, unprovoked invasion, and also for the widows of the war and the soldiers who fight valiantly for their country's freedom and protection of loved ones from the onslaught of a nation that calls itself a brother. She will demonstrate how the arts assist in healing and are intimately involved in the resistance against this attempted annihilation of the Ukrainian culture.
