## **WE WELCOME YOU TODAY**

#### We would like to remind our visitors of the following;:

- All people are encouraged to participate in the sacred services of our Church. We hope that you will be able to worship as well as have fellowship with us. Should you wish any information about the Orthodox Faith or this parish in particular, please see the rector or any member of the church. We are able to place you on our mailing list.
- Only Orthodox Christians may receive the Eucharist (Holy Communion) in the Orthodox Church. In like manner, Orthodox Christians may not receive the sacraments in an non-Orthodox Church. While we hope that one day all Christians will find unity and be able to approach the chalice of our Lord together, we observe the teachings of the Church that the Eucharist is a gift of unity and not a means of unity.

#### We remind our faithful and visitors of the following guidelines concerning the Holy Sacraments in the Orthodox Church.

- Orthodox Christians are urged to receive Holy Communion frequently.
- ❖ Communicants should be at peace with others before approaching the chalice(Mt 5:23-24)
- Realize the importance of making a thorough examination of sins and transgressions against God, ourselves and others and having prayed for forgiveness before coming to Holy Communion.
- Frequent communicants should come to Holy Confession at least four times a year (during the four fasting periods of the year). and additionally when an examination of conscience reveals the necessity to do so in order to heal any sinful behavior.
- Communicants should fast from all foods and liquids from the evening before receiving Holy Communion.
- Communicants should read prayers in preparation for receiving Holy Communion.
- ❖ All Orthodox Christians must receive the sacraments at least once a year.
- Those who are late for Divine Liturgy ( after the reading of the Epistle and Gospel) should not approach the chalice.
- Those who are ill or who have special physical needs are exempt from the above guidelines.
- Infants and children (up to the age of seven) who are Orthodox Christians may receive Holy Communion and are exempt from the above guidelines.

Thank you for gathering to worship with us today. Together we have glorified the One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. May we be brought closer to one another and closer to God by following the eternal teachings of our Lord.



# Lesson from the Acts of the Apostles

(c. 20, v. 16-18; 28-36)

In those days, Paul decided to sail past Ephesus, as he did not want to be delayed in the province of Asia, for he was hurrying to be at Jerusalem, if possible on the day of Pentecost. From Miletus he summoned the Presbyters of the Church of Ephesus. When they came, he said to them: "Take care of yourselves and of all the flock, of which the Holy Spirit has made you Bishops. Guard the Church of God, which he has won for himself with his own blood. I know that after my departure ferocious wolves will enter among you and they will not spare the flock. Even from among yourselves men will arise and teach perverse doctrines, in order to draw away the disciples after themselves."

"Therefore, watch and remember that for three years, day and night, I never ceased to advise everyone of you with tears. Now I commend you to God and to his gracious Son, who can build you up and give you the inheritance among all the saints."

"I have never coveted anyone's gold, or silver, or clothes. You know well enough that these hands of mine have provided for my needs and my companions. I have always given you an example that by such hard work we must help our weak brethren. Remember the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, 'who said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive."

With these words he knelt down and prayed with them all.

Пильнуйте себе і всіх тих, кого Господь ввірив вам . Дух Святий обрав вас, аби ви стали пастирями церкви Божої, яку Він викупив кров'ю Свого власного Сина. Знаю я, що після того, як я піду, деякі люди, немов люті вовки з'являться поміж вас. І не помилують вони стада. Навіть серед вас заведуться такі люди, які перекрутять правду, щоб потягнулися за ними учні. Тож будьте обережні! Пам'ятайте, як я невпинно закликав зі сльозами кожного з вас день і ніч, протягом трьох років, триматися істинного життя. А тепер доручаю вас Богу і Слову Його милості. Слово Господнє може укріпити вас і дати вам спадщину милості Божій серед усіх людей святих.

Ніколи я не зазіхав на чиєсь срібло, золото або гарне вбрання. Ви самі знаєте, що мої руки служили потребам моїм і тих людей, які були зі мною. Кожним своїм вчинком я показував, що тяжкою працею ми мусимо допомагати немічним. Необхідно пам'ятати слова Господа Ісуса, які Він сказав: "Справжнє щастя в тому, щоб віддавати, а не в тому, щоб брати"». Як промовив це Павло, всі стали на коліна молитися.

# Gospel According to St. John

(c. 17, v. 1-13)

At that time, Jesus lifted up his eyes to heaven and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son. Then your Son will glorify you, for you have given him authority over all mankind, and empowered him to grant eternal life to those whom you have entrusted to him."

"Now, eternal life means to know you as the only true God, and to know Jesus Christ as your messenger. I have glorified you on earth, I have accomplished the task you have given me to do. Now, Father, glorify me in your presence with that glory which I had with you before the world was created."

"I have manifested your name to the men you gave me out of the world. They were yours, and you have given them to me, and they have kept your commandments. Now they know that all my gifts come from you, because I gave them your doctrines, they have received them, they know that I have come from you, and they believe that you have sent me."

"I have a request to make for them. I do not make this request for other men, but for those you have entrusted to me. For they are yours, all that is mine is yours, what is yours is mine, and I am glorified in them. Now I am not remaining in this world any longer, but they still remain in this world, because I am coming to you!"

"Holy Father, keep in thy name those you have entrusted to me. Then they will be united also, as we are. As long as I was with them in this world, I kept and protected in thy name those whom you entrusted to me. None of them was lost except the Son of perdition in fulfillment of the Scripture. But now I am coming to you, and I am speaking these words while I am still in this world, so that they may have full measure of my joy in themselves."

# Sponsor-A-Day Program Update

At the annual parish meeting held in October 2023 the parish voted to approve the Finance Committee's recommendation to implement a Sponsorship program to raise money for the church's General Fund. The General Fund is used to pay the day-to-day operating expenses of the church and church properties (Ex: utilities, insurance, salaries, etc.).

Our 10/2022-9/2023 General Fund expenses were approximately \$150,000 (10/21-9/22 was more, at approximately \$162,500) and our 2024 member obligations are \$725 per member. With about 100 members (our current membership), member obligations will cover about \$72,500 of expenses (less than half of our expected annual expenses). Historically, the gap between member obligations and expenses has been covered largely by the generous donations of our church organizations, parishioners, and friends. But, with so many (38) of our members passing away over the last 5 years, the gap is greater than ever.

The Sponsor-A-Day program is a way to contribute to the church's financial well-being beyond obligations. It costs approximately \$450 per day to operate the church, hall, and rectory. If you are able and interested in sponsoring a day of operating expenses (or a half day or any portion of a day), please complete the form on the back of the bulletin and provide it, along with your donation, to Treasurer Brittany Brettell.



## **Emergency Plea:**

During the heavy storms a couple of weeks ago, several roof leaks appeared in our buildings. On the church roof, a leak was discovered in the hall side stairwell to the choir loft. Another leak was discovered at the upstairs hall wall next to the parking lot and additional shingles were blown off the roof. The Parish Council had a contractor come down and investigate the possible reason for the new leaks. It was discovered that the flashing between the shingles and the walls had pulled away from the walls allowing water to get inside the buildings. During the inspections it was determined that the shingles on the hall roof have gone past their life expectancy. The hall roof shingles were last replaced about 25-30 years ago. The first contractor is also recommending, with the flashing repairs, that the hall roof shingles should be replaced. The Parish Council is also meeting with two other contractors and getting two more additional estimates for this work. Currently the first contractor has provided an estimate of approximately \$50,000 for the hall roof replacement and the church roof repair. The Parish Council has received pledges in the amount of \$25,000 for this work. Parish council is asking for your help in meeting raising monies in order to not have to take any bank loans or out for this work. # Fund Raiser for Saint Sophia Seminary

At the 2024 Annual Meeting of the Guardians of the Metropolia, a philanthropic organization of the UOC of the USA the members voted to fund a scholarship for a seminarian at Saint Sophia's. Near the end of that meeting, our Eminences Metropolitan Antony and Archbishop Daniel asked the members of the Guardians of the Metropolia when they return to their parishes to see if they could create local fundraisers to raise money for additional Scholarships for the upcoming 2024/2025 school year.

The majority of new Priests and Deacons ordained by the UOC of the USA are graduates of St Sophia Seminary in South Bound Brook, NJ. The programs provide in-residence and hybrid residence /distance programs for those called to ministry in the church. Church School Administrators, Sub-Deacons, Deacons, and Priests are all accommodated in various programs.
